

## **Legalities**

**These are various bans and ordinances outside the regular local, state, and federal laws, that will change from time to time that we would like you to be aware of so that all of us stay in compliance with the local government.**

- 1. There is a curfew for children under 17 for Ector County and the city of Odessa. Children under 17 cannot be on the streets without their parent or guardian  
Sunday – Thursday after 11:00 p.m.  
Friday & Saturday after midnight**
  
- 2. Ector County and the city of Odessa are under a burn ban. This means during the burn ban, county residents will be allowed to barbeque in grills that have an iron grate, welding will be allowed only for commercial purposes and using a burn barrel is prohibited as well as any other outdoor open fire.**
  
- 3. Water restrictions are in place for Ector County and the city of Odessa we ask that you follow the following restrictions as they could pertain to you:**
  - a. Vehicle washing is limited to commercial and mobile car washing only.**
  - b. No personal washing of vehicles.**
  - c. Washing down of sidewalks, walkways, driveways, parking lots, streets and gutters is prohibited**
  - d. Washing down of building is prohibited, unless for fire protection.**
  - e. All water leaks must be repaired within a reasonable time frame**
